2011-2012 Code of Conduct for Members

To all Members and Parents: Please take the time to read through this document as it contains valuable information



- Please do not bring any nuts or foods containing nuts to the meetings, parties, outings and camping; we have members who are allergic to nuts this year.
- For those members who have food allergies and health conditions, we ask that the parent(s)/guardian(s) either stay during the meeting or be close by the school at all times in case of an emergency.
- If a member cannot come to the meeting, please call or email your section leader prior to Friday's meeting.
- Please take all the forms you receive at the meeting home to your parent/guardian so they can sign the forms.

- All members shall obey the leaders at all times; this includes when the leader asks to get ready for opening and closing ceremonies in addition to the section activities.
- Members shall wear their uniform to the meetings unless otherwise informed by the scouters. Jeans are not acceptable. Members shall also respect their uniforms including keeping it clean and tidy and wearing the complete uniform which includes the shirt, pants and neckerchief.
- Please do not bring any soft drinks into the gym during the meetings; if spilled, it will create a sticky floor. Water is acceptable.
- For those in the Beaver and Cub sections, please inform a leader if you need to go to the washroom or to take a drink. Members are to stay inside the school during the Scouting meeting and are not allowed to go outside on their own.
- From time to time, there will be decorations or items set up on the walls in the gym, please do not touch, destroy or rip them out. Remember that we respect other people's work.
- It is recommended that members bring a pair of indoor shoes to wear during the winter months to avoid getting the gym floor wet and to prevent potential injuries. Boots can be left inside the entrance.
- Members who constantly disrupt sessions and who do not respect the leaders and others will be given a verbal warning. If the behavior persists, the section leader will speak to the parents.
- Above all, please respect others and others will respect you.
